I have been advised to share some very important information regarding Material Safety Data Sheets sometimes referred to as MSDS.

If your course involves using hazardous substances such as may be the case for beauty, construction, science, photography and hospitality, it is important that you read the relevant MSDS. This information will enable you to identify the hazards associated with a product that you are using and also help to protect you from those hazards including how to handle them safely and what steps to take in an emergency.

Although the substances that you will be asked to use by your teachers will be relatively safe, it is important that you gain an understanding of what is in the MSDS so that you are aware of everything that they contain. The relevant MSDS will be available either from your teacher or a technician if they are involved in your classes.
